

DEAR DARKE COUNTY ELECTRONICS RECYCLER,

**WHEN AND WHERE THE COLLECTION TAKES PLACE:**

We are pleased to announce our Electronics Recycling Day for the drop-off, collection and recycling of electronics equipment. It will be on Wednesday, May 23, 2018, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at 1 Shot Scrap and Recycling, 6377 Hahn Rd, Bradford, Ohio. If you take US Rt 36 to the flashing light at Gettysburg, you'll turn the opposite way of Gettysburg. Look for the signs!!!

**TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS PROGRAM, THERE IS NO NEED TO PREREGISTER** After many suggestions and complaints, the district has decided to try this event without the requirement of preregistration!!! To try to help alleviate long lines, we ask that those with the last name A-M arrive between 9 am and Noon and those with the last name N-Z arrive between 1:00 pm and 5:00 pm.

**ASSIGNED TIME TO BRING IN YOUR EQUIPMENT:**

By assigning a specific time frame for arrival, we are trying to circumvent long lines, longer waits, and traffic jams. However, if something should occur that prevents you from taking in your equipment at your assigned time, you may still take it for collection as long as you arrive before 5 pm. You will be served on a first come, first served basis. We ask that those with the last name A-M arrive between 9 am and Noon and those with the last name N-Z arrive between 1:00 pm and 5:00 pm.

**WHY WON'T YOU ACCEPT CRT AND PROJECTION TELEVISIONS:**

Due to the rising cost of recycling televisions, the district can no longer accept televisions during our Electronics Recycling Day. Most neighboring solid waste districts either don't accept televisions or are charging \$1 per inch per television. 1 Shot Scrap and Recycling will accept CRT and projection televisions for a fee. Please note: Fees at 1 Shot are subject to change after May 23, 2018.

**WHERE IS EQUIPMENT TAKEN TO BE RECYCLED:**

All of the equipment that you bring in will be disassembled for recycling. All hard drives will be drilled on-site to protect your personal information!!! Nothing will be dumped in a landfill or sent to China, where it has the potential to pollute soil, water, and air, endangering both the environment and human health.

**SUPERVISED DARKE COUNTY COMMUNITY SERVICE**

When you take your equipment to the collection point, Darke County Community Service crews will unload your vehicle. These persons will be supervised at all times by a uniformed Sheriff's deputy. Also, there will be other volunteers available to help you, including supervisors from the electronics recycler.
