

DEAR DARKE COUNTY ELECTRONICS RECYCLER,

**WHEN AND WHERE THE COLLECTION TAKES PLACE:**

We are pleased to announce our Electronics Recycling Day for the drop-off, collection and recycling of electronics equipment. It will be on Thursday, May 26, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. in the Swine Barn at the Darke County Fairgrounds, 800 Sweitzer St., in Greenville, Ohio.

**TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS PROGRAM YOU MUST PREREGISTER** by filling out the form on the other side of this letter and RETURNING IT BY May 13, 2016 at 4:30 pm, to the Darke County Solid Waste Management District Office at 684 Wagner, Suite C, in Greenville. "ALL" DARKE COUNTY RESIDENTS, BUSINESSES, INDUSTRIES, NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS, AND SCHOOLS ARE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE. At the May 26, 2016 collection, the district will also be accepting food donations for the Grace Resurrection Food Pantry on Water Street in Greenville.

**ASSIGNED TIME TO BRING IN YOUR EQUIPMENT:**

When you preregister to participate in this program, you will be assigned a time that will be convenient for you to take your equipment to the fairgrounds. By assigning a satisfactory time for you, we are trying to circumvent long lines, longer waits, and traffic jams. However, if something should occur that prevents you from taking in your equipment at your assigned time, you may still take it for collection as long as you are preregistered. Times are assigned on a first come, first served basis.

**WHERE IS EQUIPMENT TAKEN TO BE RECYCLED:**

All of the equipment that you bring in will be picked up by and taken to an electronics recycler. The electronics will be repaired and rebuilt for reuse or will be disassembled for recycling. Nothing will be dumped in a landfill or sent to China, where it has the potential to pollute soil, water, and air, endangering both the environment and human health.

**SUPERVISED DARKE COUNTY COMMUNITY SERVICE**

When you take your equipment to the collection point, Darke County Community Service crews will unload your vehicle. These persons will be supervised at all times by a uniformed Sheriff's deputy. Also, there will be other volunteers available to help you, including supervisors from the electronics recycler.

**TEAM EFFORT MAKES THIS PROGRAM POSSIBLE:**

This program is made possible through a team effort of the Darke County Environmental Council for Business and Industry, Darke County Solid Waste Management District and Policy Committee, Darke County Board of Commissioners, Darke County Buildings and Grounds Department, Darke County Common Pleas Court, Darke County Adult Probation, Darke County Homeland Security & EMA, Darke County Agricultural Society, Darke County General Health District's Environmental Division, and Darke County Sheriff's Office.
